Submission Instructions for TYDE Fellowships

SUBMISSION DEADLINE: Friday, January 19, 2018

Steps for Submission:

1. Click the “Log In” button to access your existing account or create a new user.

You must login to access your dashboard.

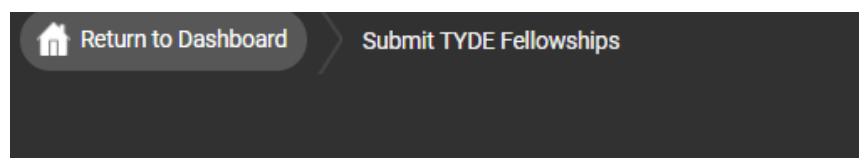
2. Once logged into the portal, select the yellow button “Access My Dashboard.”

3. You will then select the large blue square, “Submit TYDE Fellowship Application”.
 - a. If you have previously started or submitted an application it will be listed below the button.



4. Select the appropriate poster submission type in the drop-down menu.

5. Answer the required questions
 - a. Once you have finished click “Save” or “Submit”



6. Once all of the questions have been answered, select either the “Save Submission” or “Submit TYDE Fellowship” yellow button at the top of the page.
 - a. Once successfully submitted, you will receive a confirmation by email.
 - b. You may edit your application after you have submitted.
 - c. After the deadline has passed, all applications will be reviewed by the Awards Committee.
