## SRBR 2022

### Rhythms of Life: From Molecule to Policy

The theme of the 2022 meeting reflects the extent to which biological clocks impact essentially all aspects of ecology, physiology, and disease in a wide variety of species and will highlight the relevance of biological clocks to both science and society. In recent years, discoveries regarding the role that biological clocks play in human health have exploded, revealing the importance of such clocks for sleep, metabolism, cardiovascular disease, mental health, aging, and cancer. We have reached an exciting time when discoveries first reported at previous SRBR meetings are being applied to the understanding and treatment of human disease and the planning of healthier communities.

In addition to our extensive scientific program, the SRBR meeting holds a Trainee Professional Development Day the day before start of the meeting, which provides lectures on topics ranging from the conceptual foundations of the study of biological rhythms, new research tools in chronobiology, to mentoring and grant writing. Finally, SRBR 2022 will be preceded by a three-day Chronobiology Summer School hosted by the University of Florida.
