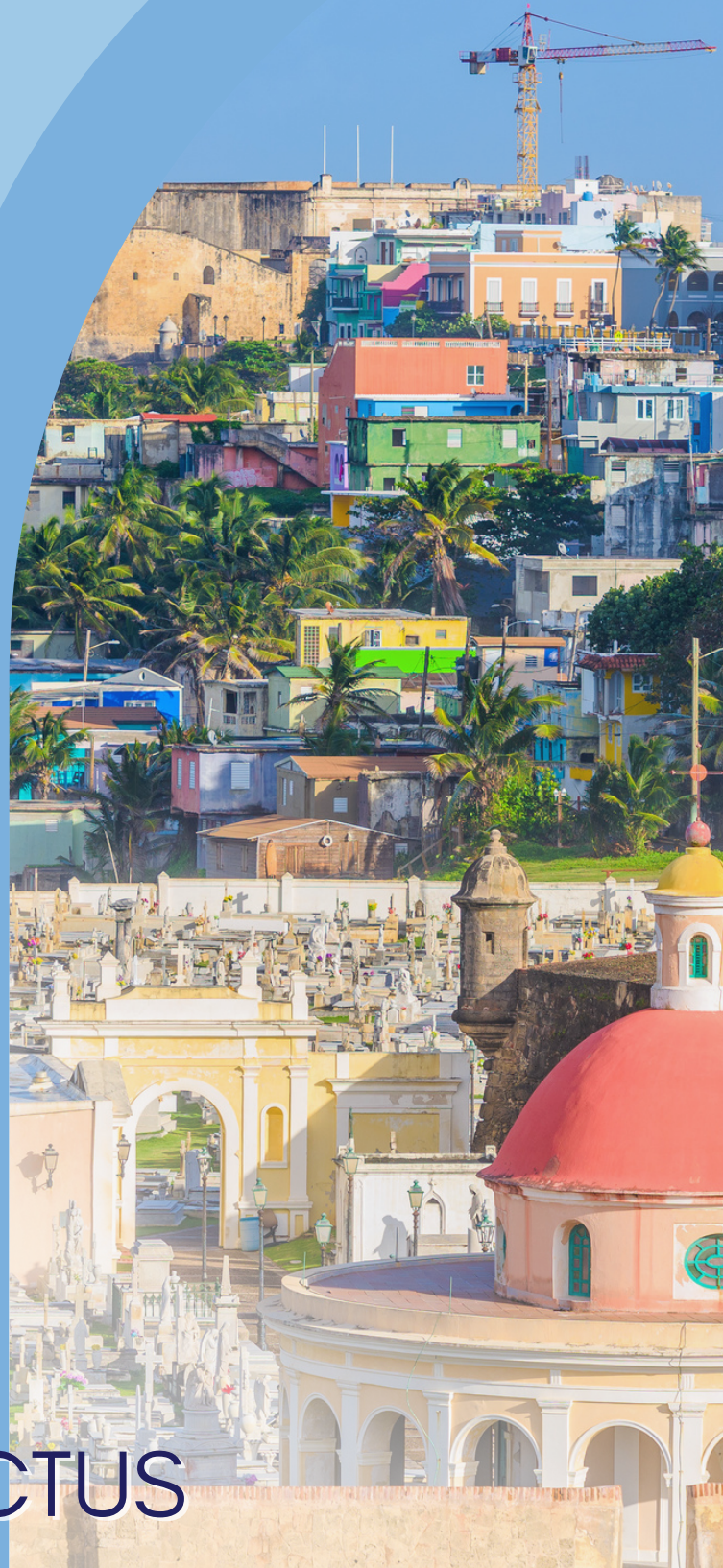

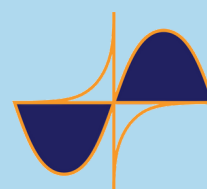
OUR MISSION

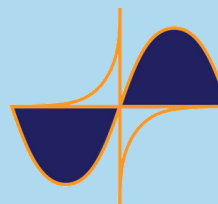
